

Now For Equus?

There was plenty of emotion as super mare Carry On Alice made it a winning swansong at Scottsville on Saturday to win the SA Fillies Sprint. The final item on her racing bucket list must be an Equus Award. She was overshadowed by Majmu, Alboran Sea and Smart Call, in respective champion age group awards over the years, and by Captain Of All and Talktothestars, in the Champion Sprinter category. She must be odds-on to lift the Champion Sprinter and Champion Older Female award this season.

GINA WHO?

There has been some critical reaction to the participation in the Investec Derby this Saturday of 25 year old Gina Mangan, the apprentice who has ridden only one winner. On Saturday she lines up against Ryan Moore and Frankie Dettori on 1000-1 outsider Diore Lia and insists she has every right to be there. "I'll be donating my riding fee, plus any prize-money that comes our way. The hype I want around my ride in the Derby is the charity, but I am licenced and do feel I deserve a chance like any other jockey," she said.

Riverton's Record

Riverton Stud's only three previous runners in the Gr1 Gold Medallion – Captain Of All, Potent Power and Link Man – all won. So there was some pressure on Brett Crawford on Saturday to win the 2yo Gr1 race with Al Mariachi. After looking dangerous, he eventually ran a not disgraced 2,50 lengths third behind Sand And Sea and Varallo. Duncan Barry and his team won't be complaining.

A few hours later, Magical Wonderland won the Listed Kenilworth Fillies Nursery in 73,91 secs, while her stablemate Dutch Philip won the Gr3 Cape Of Good Hope Nursery a half hour later in 73,92 secs. 


Captain Of Speed

Progeny of former champion sire Captain Al have a superb record in Scottsville's Gr1 sprint jackpot day. His sons and daughters have won each of the four G1 races on at least one occasion, and Carry On Alice carried the flag in the SA Fillies Sprint on Saturday. Captain Al also went close in the G1 Tsogo Sun Sprint, where his sons Search Party and Barbosa finished second and third respectively, for a generous swinger dividend of R95-20!
